




Prime	<div>Communication and Language</div> <div>We will enjoy listening to stories and try to remember what happened. We will begin to understand two part instructions. 	<div>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</div> <div>We will play with one or more children, extending and elaborating play ideas. We will increasingly follow rules, understanding why they are important. We will be increasingly independent in meeting our own care needs, using the toilet, washing/drying our hands.</div>		
	<div>Physical development</div> <div>We will use large muscle movements to dance, wave flags and scarves, paint and make marks. We will skip, hop, jump and stand on one leg in dance lessons and in play. We will enjoy yoga lessons, dance lessons and visits to the Forest school.</div>		
Specific	<div>Literacy</div> <div>We will develop our phonological awareness so we can spot rhymes and clap syllables in words. We will begin to understand that print has meaning, in books and our environment.</div>	<div>Mathematics</div> <div>We will develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects (subitise). We will recite numbers past 5 and say one number for each item in order. We will explore and talk about 2d shapes.</div>	
	<div>Expressive Arts and Design</div> <div>We will remember and sing entire songs. We will explore colour and colour mixing. We will draw with increasing complexity, including circles for faces and extra detail</div>	<div>Understanding the world</div> <div>We will begin to make sense of our own and families life history – looking at pictures of ourselves as babies, using words then, now, past. We will talk about what we see using a wide vocabulary – autumn resources leaves, conkers, shells, pine cones etc</div>
