

Get Connected Community Broadband – Free connection for families needing internet for online learning

Privacy Notice

Hartlepool Borough Council and Hartlepower's "Get Connected Community Broadband" project are offering a 4G Wi-Fi router and internet connection for families where children do not have an internet connection to help with online learning for the period up to 31st May 2021.

By providing your details you are consenting to this information being passed via your child's school to Hartlepool Borough Council and the Get Connected for the purposes of funding and providing a Wi-Fi router and connection. You will need to provide your name, address, telephone number and, if you have one, an email address.

You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting Get Connected directly on 01429 555994. However, without consent Hartlepool Borough Council and Get Connected are unable to fund and provide a Wi-Fi connection.

Towards the end of the period of free connection, the Get Connected team will contact you to discuss options for continuing or stopping the service. This does not affect your right to withdraw your consent at any time.

Your information will not be used for any other purpose than funding and providing a router and Wi-Fi connection. It will be kept securely by all parties and will only be kept as long as necessary for the purpose of funding and providing you with a router and Wi-Fi connection.
