


<p>In writing, we will create an emotive diary about the character needing a heart transplant using our core text. We will also be using 'Pig Heart Boy' to support our debate and writing a discussion about whether animal organs should be used in human transplants. Children will write a set of instructions on how to give CPR. We will continue to learn grammatical terms, applying them in their own writing and identifying them. Maths		Number facts			
<p>In Maths, we will be consolidating our addition, subtraction, multiplication and division methods using decimal numbers and applying them to reasoning questions. We will look at measure including volume and conversions, geometry including measuring, drawing and finding angles and translating and reflecting shapes on a co-ordinate grid. Following this, children will secure their work on fractions, decimals and percentages.</p>		<p>I can quickly recall fraction, decimal and percentage equivalents for one half, one quarter, one third, one fifth, one eighth, one tenth, one hundredth, one thousandth</p>			
Science		History/Geography			
<p>In Science, our topic is 'Animals and humans' and we will be looking at the circulatory system. We will identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, explaining the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood (including the pulse and clotting) and then complete an investigation.</p>		<p>In History, we will be looking at Crime and Punishment from the Romans to present day. We will be investigating how crime and punishment has changed throughout the years. In Geography, we will explore our local area and the wider town of Hartlepool, through fieldwork activities.</p>

<p>In Art and Design, we will discover how artists use layers and juxtaposition to create artwork which explores identity. Children will think about their own likes, hobbies and things that would reflect their personalities to create a layered portrait.</p>		<p>In Computing, we will focus on developing basic skills. This will include using a topic called My Online Life. They will look at online relationships and online reputation. Children will research items online and learn how to keep safe.</p>
