

<p>In English, the majority of our writing will be inspired by our core text, 'The Wolf Wilder' by Katherine Rundell. The children will write instructions linked to science and a newspaper report about events from 'The Wolf Wilder.' Plus, a persuasive leaflet about ways we can help save the rainforest. In daily reading lessons, the children will develop their reading fluency skills using a variety of texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry linked to the curriculum areas we are learning about. The children will recap grammar skills learnt in previous year groups and explore and use new grammatical terminology, which they will transfer into their written work.</p>		<p>Core Texts:</p>

<p>In Maths, we will be revisiting how to calculate fractional amounts of a whole and multiplying and dividing by 10 or 100. We will be collecting and summarising data, looking at positions and translations on coordinate grids and problem solving using all four operations. Times tables will be practised each day using a variety of different techniques to enable the children to recall multiplication facts instantly. Arithmetic skills will be taught daily encouraging the children to apply these skills to problem solving.</p>		<p>To quickly recall all multiplication facts for the Multiplication Times Tables Check Assessment.</p>

<p>In Science we will be learning all about grouping materials according to whether they are a solid, liquid or gas. We will also observe the changing state of materials when they are heated or cooled.</p>		<p>In Geography, we will be learning all about the Amazon Rainforest in South America. We will be learning about what it is like to live in some of the villages in the rainforest and what activities are available there. We will also be thing about how the rainforest is changing and how it can be protected.</p>
