



<p>In English, we will be making sure we are writing simple sentences, which include a capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks. We will be extending sentences, joining them together using 'and', 'but' and 'so'. Within grammar, we will identify and use singular and plurals. We will use the suffixes 'ing', 'ed'. We will read together every day sharing books, answering questions with evidence from the text. We will speculate about characters and the meaning of new vocabulary. We will also have a phonics lesson each day, identifying different phonemes within words, which will help with our reading and writing. <p>In Maths we will be measuring capacity, volume, length and height. Compare, describe and solve practical problems for capacity and volume (for example, full/empty, more than, less than, half, half full, quarter). We will be recognising and finding halves and quarters of objects, shapes or quantities. We will solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays.</p>		<p>Halves and quarters of numbers.</p>
