


<p>In Maths, we will be revising and applying the secure knowledge of 4 operations to reasoning questions. We will be revising and applying the knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages to both arithmetic and reasoning questions. Children will also be revising measure including area, perimeter, volume and conversions to reasoning and problem-solving questions. Children will be confidently revising and applying their knowledge of how to solve arithmetic questions and discussing their answers.</p>		<p>Apply knowledge of all previous learning in a variety of contexts.</p>

<p>In Science, our topic is 'How we see things'. We will be identifying and naming the parts of the eye. Children will learn about light sources and non-light sources. Children will learn that light travels in straight lines and will prove this using mirrors. Children will be investigating how white light is created.</p>		<p>In Geography, children will be learning about their local area. They will be using maps to plot the different counties and regions. They will be locating main features of their region and explain why our region might meet the people's needs. The children will be creating a map of the places that they have visited.</p>
