


Children will be writing a piece of description, using expanded noun phrases to hook the reader. In reading, children will be learning a play script for their Year 6 leavers assembly. <p>In Maths, we will be revising and applying the secure knowledge of 4 operations to real life problem solving. Children will learn how to apply their maths knowledge and skills to help them prepare for secondary school. <p>In Science, our topic is Electricity. We will be learning how to draw circuits, how to identify symbols and how to create a circuit. Children will be creating a range of circuits and investigating how the voltage in a circuit affects the brightness of a bulb. Children will be learning about renewable and non-renewable sources of energy are.</p>		<p>In History, children will be learning about the Mayan civilisation. Children will be identifying on a map where the Mayans lived. They will be looking at the life of a Mayan, using artefacts and looking at different sources to investigate how a Mayan's life was different to British life now. Children will be looking at the Mayan Gods, foods, trade and the hierarchy.</p>
