English		Core texts			
<p>In English this term, we will be writing using our core texts as a stimulus. We will be writing recounts, information texts (one linked to geography and some narrative and persuasion). We will be looking at writing with capital letters and full stops. In reading, we will be looking at a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. This will be completed daily in class using an assortment of texts and resources. We will read each day in order to improve fluency in class. In grammar we will be learning about vocabulary, different word classes and how to use them and how then to apply them in our writing.</p>		<p>Core Texts:</p>

<p>We will be exploring multiplication and division using the times tables that we know. We will be exploring fractions both in a set of objects and of a number. We will begin to learn to tell the time on analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII, and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks. In measurement, we will be investigating mass, volume and money.</p>		<p>We will be quickly recalling and applying in our maths doubling numbers and the 2 x table and division facts.</p>			
Science		History/Geography			
<p>In Science this term, our topic is Light and Shadow. We will be recognising that we need light to see and noticing that light is reflected from surfaces. We will be discussing the dangers of the sun and investigating shadows.</p>		<p>In History, we will be exploring the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will be discovering what life was like in the three periods of the Stone Age (Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic), the Bronze Age and the Iron Age.</p>

		<p>The children will use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation and they will apply those skills to create a story-based animation. We will focus on keeping safe online.</p>
