<b>English</b>		<b>Core texts</b>			
<p>In English this term, we will be writing using our core text and History topic as a stimulus. We will be writing an information text, a description and a recount. We will be looking at writing with a range of punctuation including inverted commas for direct speech. In reading, we will be looking at a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. This will be completed daily in class using an assortment of texts and resources. We will read each day in order to improve fluency in class. <b>Maths</b>		<b>Number facts</b>			
<p>We will be exploring addition and subtraction using formal methods. We will be exploring number and place value. In Geometry, we will be looking at properties of shapes and angles in turns.</p>		<p>We will be quickly recalling and applying in our maths square times table and division facts.</p>			
<b>Science</b>		<b>History/Geography</b>			
<p>In Science this term, our topic is Forces and Magnets. We will look at pushes, pulls, friction and magnets. We will discover how we use forces and magnets in everyday life and compare how things move on different surfaces.</p>		<p>We will be carrying on with our History topic. In Geography, we will be looking at North America and identifying countries and states within it. We will explore the physical geography of the Rockies and Mount St Helens. We will also compare New York to where we live.</p>

		<p>The children will be using Scratch to sequence sounds and creating sequences in a block-based programming language to make music. We will focus on keeping safe online.</p>
